Fleet Town Council will therefore be holding a consultation on this draft plan which we are aiming to launch for a period of 6 weeks immediately after the council elections in May. You will be able to submit your views via an online survey or via hard copies that will be included both in the Newsletter and be available from our offices in The Harlington.
