Firework Fiesta

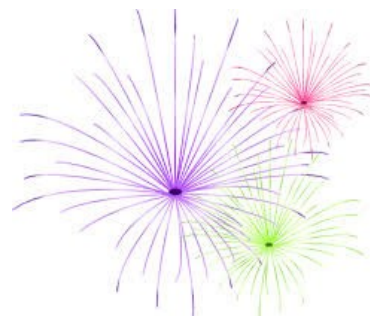
Saturday 7th November
