To date, the hedge had not been replaced and Cllr Appleton pointed out that there was an Article 4 Direction to preserve hedgerows in conservation areas they are one of the characteristics of a CA. If hedgerows are removed then this may not be considered a conservation area. The Committee decided that the local ward member should make contact with the Hart District Council Enforcement Officer on this issue. Cllr Richard Robinson agreed to progress this action.</p> <p>ACTION: Cllr Robinson to contact Hart District Council Enforcement Officer.</p>

If confirmation is received that the land belongs to FTC , the Committee has asked for an item to be put onto the Agenda for Full Council “to consider if any action is required relating to the land at the rear of 7 Richard Close”</p> <p>ACTION Deputy Clerk to who ascertain if the land belongs to Fleet Town Council and to have it included on the Full Council agenda if appropriate.</p>
