OBJECTION

- 1. Illumination is intrusive and unnecessary in that the Albert Street signs are in a residential area and the other signs are in well lit areas and do not need illumination
- 2. There should only be two signs
- 3. The signs are too large particularly with flag poles on top. They should be reduced to a more reasonable size.
- 4. Hoarding advertising should be limited to:
 - 1 x set in Albert Street
 - 2 x sets in Fleet Road
 - 1 x set in Kings Road

NOTE: This is more advertising than Edenbrook or Crookham Park have for a whole housing Development

5. The Officer's view was that the development was sympathetic to the conservation area, this signage is not.
