This year's meeting will include presentations by Fleet Town Council, displays from community organisations and updates on The Harlington Development and Fleet's Neighbourhood Plan.

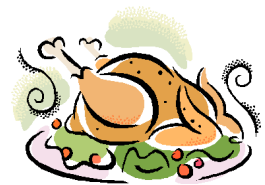
### *Fleet Neighbourhood Plan*

A Neighbourhood Plan is a document that allows local councils to set planning policies and shape development in their area. Fleet Town Council has been working to create a Neighbourhood Plan for Fleet - a draft plan is nearly complete. Fleet Town Council will therefore be holding a consultation on this draft plan which we are aiming to launch for a period of 6 weeks immediately after the council elections in May. You will be able to submit your views via an online survey or via hard copies that will be included both in the Newsletter and be available from our offices in The Harlington.
