

Notice of Intention to Terminate Rights to Unused Grave Spaces in Fleet Cemetery

Under the Local Authorities' Cemetery Order 1977, a burial authority may in specified circumstances terminate the exclusive right of burial for a grave space which has been unused for 75 years or more.
