Over the last four years, Fleet Town Council has been committed to making the Harlington offer an increased range of entertainment and recreational facilities to local residents and visitors. The Council's strategy has been to invest in the Harlington to make the venue more attractive. The results are starting to be seen with the public subsidy being reduced, allowing the Council to make an even greater investment in the facility and other Town Council assets.

The Town Council has invested in the annual Pantomime that received great reviews, and brought many young families to The Harlington. We have recently converted the old Carnival Hall into a dedicated dance studio and hope this will bring dance schools, classes and exercise groups to the Harlington. We have been progressively redecorating the building and making the facility more "user friendly."

The Town Council would like to take a "rain check" and find out if the changes are what the residents of Fleet want. We will be conducting a survey to seek your views on what the Harlington has to offer now and in the future, both in entertainment and recreational facilities.

We have elected to use an independent market survey firm to analyse the results so that the conclusions of the survey are not prejudiced by the Town Councils own views.

So please help us by completing the survey and letting us know what we can do to help make Fleet an even better place to visit.
